more availability for in-person, non-COVID-19 patient needs.

Harvard and Littleton Dedicated as Symptom Free Sites



Beginning Monday, May 4, 2020, we will re-open our Harvard office as a symptom free site for adults.

Our Littleton office is a symptom free site for pediatric care.



We've implemented new processes that ensure we only schedule visits in Littleton and Harvard for patients who have no signs of respiratory illnesses. Patients arriving without an appointment, or having an illness upon arrival, are asked to return to their vehicle to call to set up an appointment.

In-person appointments held in Harvard for Adult Medicine ensure a safe and private setting for services such as high blood pressure, diabetes, rashes, significant orthopedic issues, needed vaccinations and headaches. Lab appointments for adults will primarily take place in Harvard.


Littleton is dedicated to in-person Pediatrics' appointments, including routine exams, immunizations, chronic disease management, follow-up visits, and lab tests.





With a priority on patient and staff safety, and to further support social distancing, we will have a limited number of patient visits scheduled per day in Harvard. Our check-in process has been streamlined with every precautionary measure in mind.

Patients are asked to arrive right at their appointment time. The check-in team will promptly bring patients to the exam room, bypassing the waiting room completely. Since the waiting room is not being used, patients will be asked to wait in their vehicles if arriving early.



In some cases, the discussion portion of the appointment may occur by telehealth, with the in-person exam held in the Harvard office. This structure is another precautionary measure to help lessen the amount of in-person contact during COVID-19 restrictions.

In addition to maintaining social distancing, we ask that all patients, guests, staff, and providers wear face masks while in the Harvard office. Some providers may also be observed wearing additional PPE.

We continue to offer telehealth appointments for those visits that do not require an in-person meeting, or for patients who prefer to only meet virtually.

Many adult and pediatric services are offered via telehealth such as muscle and joint pain, sleep concerns, skin conditions, acne, high blood pressure, headaches, mental health, allergies, and more.
