

## Travel Health Services at Passport Health

Passport Health is an external resource to prepare travelers. Here's what to expect:

### Step 1: Initial Consultation

- **What you receive:**

During your in-person visit, you'll meet with a travel health specialist who will provide:

- Destination-specific travel health advice
- Recommended and/or required travel vaccines
- Information about antimalarial medications (if needed)

- **Cost:**

A one-time **initial consultation fee** covers the visit and all the advice and recommendations provided.

### Step 2: Prescription for Antimalarial Medication (If Needed)

- If you decide to take antimalarial medication for your trip, you'll need a **prescription** from a licensed medical provider at Passport Health. Acton Medical Associates providers do not prescribe based on the recommendations of Passport Health providers.

- **What happens next:**

- You'll schedule a **telehealth appointment** with a Nurse Practitioner (NP) at Passport Health.
- This video visit typically lasts a few minutes and ensures that the medication is appropriate for you

- **Cost:**

There is an **additional \$35 fee** for the telehealth visit and prescription service.

- **After the visit:**

The NP will send the prescription directly to your pharmacy.
